ADDRESS AT TOP?

YES I'VE FINNALLY GOT AROUND TO WRITE YOU YOU, IN THE FIRST PLACE I MAS TAITING TO GET YOUR PERCENT ADDRESS, AND THEN ALSO THE BIG. SHOT AS YOU NO DOUBT HEARD ABOUT. AS PLAYED QUITE A BIG ROLL IN THE INVASION AND MA XX CAME OUT SO FAR WITH FLYING COLORS. SURE WILL BE GLAD WHEN IT GETS ALL OVER WITH SO TE CAN GET BACK TO THE GOOD OLD UNITED STATES. THIS IS THE FIRST CHANCE I'VE HAD TO WRITE STRUE THE FIRST OF JUNE, EXCEPT FOR A LITTLE NOTE IS SEND HOME STATING I WAS STILL ALL RIGHT. I REALLY FELL GOOD ABOUT THE SWELLFFIRING WE DID, ESPECIALLY AFTER BEING ON THIS SHIP OUT AT P.H. IT SHOWS YOU CAN'T KEEP A GOOD SHIP AND A SWELL BUNCH OF FELLOWS FROM HEING ON THE TOP WITH THE REST OFTHEM. I HAVEN'T RECEIVED NO CLIPPING OR NO NOTHING LIKE THAT BUT A LETTER FROM A GIRL IN BOSTON DATED THE EIGHT AND SHIP SIAD ME MADE THE PAPERS BACK THERE QUITE A BIT. TAKE IT FROM ME HEINGHAT GERERAL QUARTERS FOR THE LENGTH OF THE WE WERE, MAEN'T ANY FUN. THE OWEN'NS DIDN'T TOUCH US AND THAT WAS THE MAIN THING.

HOW DO WOU LIKE NEW YORK, BOY I GAN REMEMBER THE THREE TIMES THAT I WAS THERE. DID WE HAVE A GOOD TIME THOSE NIGHTS. WOULDN'T HIND FOR ONE OF THESE LIBERTIES' RIGHT NOW. FOR A GOOD CITY GO TO BOSTON IF YOU EVER OST A CHANGE, WHAT A PLACE.
