SCA and CSUF Co-Sponsor Chinese Social Sciences Conference Oct. 28-30

**Orange, Calif., Oct. 26, 2005** Chapman University's School of Communication Arts and California State University, Fullerton (CSUF) will co-sponsor the 11th Annual International Conference of the Association of Chinese Professors of Social Sciences in the United States (ACPSS) on October 28-30, 2005. The conference will be held on the CSUF campus.

This year, the conference will focus on Sustainable Development in China: Social Science Perspectives. Sessions will cover such topics as U.S.-China Relations Under Bush II, The Rape of Nanking and the Cause for Peace and Humanity, Chinas Foreign Relations and New Issues of Nationalism and Chinese Immigrants Within China and Overseas. Chapman University's Wenshan Jia, Ph.D., a member of the School of Communication Arts faculty, serves on the local arrangement committee for the conference. The conferences keynote speaker will be Dongtao Zou, Ph.D., professor of economics and cultures at the China Social Sciences Academy.
