## 2005 Commencement

Orange campus ceremony is Saturday, May 21

More than 12,000 parents, family and friends are expected at the 2005 commencement ceremony to be held Saturday, May 21.

Tickets are not required for the undergraduate and graduate ceremonies.

Seating is on a first-come, first-served basis. Parties may save up to 15 seats per group for arriving guests until the start of the ceremony.

Parking is free in the two campus parking structures, Argyros lot, Residence Hall lots and at Orange High School. Permits or stickers are not required to park in these lots. Guests may also park on local streets without a permit on May 21 only. The stadium lot and faculty lots are reserved for faculty.

The graduate ceremony will begin at 9 a.m. and the undergraduate ceremony will begin at 4:30 p.m. Both ceremonies will be held in Ernie Chapman Stadium. Jose Padilla, executive director of the California Rural Legal Assistance will speak at the graduate ceremony. The undergraduate ceremony keynote speaker is Max Weinberg, drummer for Bruce Springsteen and the E Street Band and music director on Late Night with Conan O'Brien.

The Department of Physical Therapy hooding ceremony will be held in Memorial Hall starting at 11:30 a.m.

The law school hooding ceremony will be held in Ernie Chapman Stadium starting at 11:30 a.m. Eileen C. Moore, associate justice of Courts of Appeals: 4th District, Division 3 will be the guest speaker at the law school ceremony.

Ernie Chapman Stadium will open to guests at 7:30 a.m. for the graduate ceremony and 2:30 p.m. for the undergraduate ceremony.
