YOLANDA KONDONASSIS

Yolanda Kondonassis is recognized as one of the world's foremost harpists, performing both as a concerto soloist and recitalist throughout the United States, Far East, and Europe. Hailed by the New York Times for her "powerful playing and musicianly energy," she made her debut at age 18 with The New York Philharmonic and has since appeared as soloist with numerous orchestras around the world such as The Cleveland Orchestra, the English Chamber Orchestra, and the Hong Kong Philharmonic, to name a few. Highlights of her 2008 -09 season include the world premiere and recording of Bright Sheng's Never Far Away: Concerto for Harp and Orchestra. As a Telarc recording artist with over 100,000 albums sold worldwide, Ms. Kondonassis has won universal critical acclaim for her thirteen discs, which include much of the standard repertoire, as well as her own transcriptions and compositions for the harp. Ms. Kondonassis' long list of honors includes top prizes in the Affiliate Artists National Auditions in New York and the Maria Korchinska International Harp Competition in Great Britain. She has been featured on CNN and PBS television as well as on National Public Radio's All Things Considered, St. Paul Sunday Morning, and Performance Today. In addition to her active performing and recording schedule, Ms. Kondonassis heads the harp departments at The Cleveland Institute of Music and Oberlin Conservatory of Music and has given master classes around the world. A native of Norman, Oklahoma, Ms. Kondonasssis received her Bachelor's and Master's degrees from The Cleveland Institute of Music as a student of Alice Chalifoux.
