Honey please dont worry too much I know it will be hard and Id be half crazy if you were in my place. This is a day that will go down in history. We of course were glad in a way to hear that it started, a lot of us will probably have to suffer but still it ~~has~~ started the ball rolling and means that now that its started the sooner its finished the sooner we will get home to our loved ones.

According to the paper the people back home acted more like it was a celebration, that may not be true but to us they should be going to

I know my darling is praying
and will be day and night
till I get home and then will
