DEAR MOM DAD AND ALL:

WELL I HAVEN'T WRITTEN FOR A COUPLE OF DATS SO HERE GOES. THERE ISN'T ANYTHING NEW
BUT I'LL TRY TO THINK UP A LITTLE SOMETHING TO SAY. I READ IN THE PAPER TODAY WHERE THAT
GIRL IN DETROIT GOT MAD BECAUSE A SOLDIER STOOD HER UP AND HAD ALL THE BOYS LEAVES IN
TOWN "NCELLED. IF IMAS HER I SUREY WOULDN'T FEEL SAFE ON THE STREETS FOR IF I HAD BEEN
HOME I WOULD HAVE COME BACK MUST TO PUNCH HER IN THE NOSE. I SUPPOSE YOU'LL HEITE ME
ABOUT THE INCIDENT BUT YOU SEE HOW THE NEWS TRAVELS.

I JUS NOTICED I ADDRESSED THIS LETTER TO NELLIE AND I SAT DOWN TO URITE TO YOU I
DONT KNOW I WAS THINKING OF, SOMETIMES I WONDER IF I HAVE GOOD SENSE, WE GET THE NEWS

THAN **Y OTHER OFFICER IN THE SQUALRON. IT SURE HUNS FURNY HARE FOR WE'LL GET IT REDULAR
FOR A WEEKNY OR SO AND THEN WE WONT GET ANY FOR ALMOST A WEEK.

I GOT A LETTER FROM AUNT MARVEL THE OTHER DAY SO I GUESS G'PA SENT MY ADDRESS TO ALLI
THE CLAN. I ANSWERED UNCLE RALPH'S LET ER THE OTHER DAY SO I'LL HAVE TO ANSWER THE REST
TONITE. I WENT! TO TOWN LAST AND SAW ABBOTT AND COSTELLO IN "WHO DONE IT?". WE GET OUR
PICTURES LATE HERE BUT WE GET
