Dear Mr. Rich:

Mr. Richard M. Tobin has given me your letter of September 5. I am profoundly grateful for your generous response with regard to my parents who are now in the Camp de Gurs. Their complete address is:

Israel Tymianka and Mrs. Fajga Rajzla Tymianka  
Camp de Gurs, Ilet F, Barraque 2, Basses Pyrénées, France.

You mention that you have been able to secure the release of many people from the Camp when funds were guaranteed for their support. I am more than willing to transfer any sum needed if you could let me know what funds would be required to secure their release.

I should like to avail myself of your kind offer to be of assistance in transferring funds to France. I herewith enclose a check for \$100.00. If it should be possible to expedite matters by cabling the money, please deduct the cable expenses from this sum.

Please let me know what other amounts may be required. In order to expedite matters, you may wire me at my expense. I shall be glad to re-imburse you for any other expenses which might be helpful in any way to my parents.
