Following is the text of the cable just received from my parents in Camp de Gurs:

DEPUIS DEUX SEMAINES EN FRANCE ATTENDONS VISA SORTIE
BIENTOT TRANSATLANTICA EST INFORME SOMMES EN BONNE SANTE

Translation: "Since two weeks in France awaiting exit visa soon. Transatlantica is informed. We are in good health."

Transatlantica is the Spanish Steamship Company with which I have prepaid passages from Bilbao to New York via Cuba. The reservations were for Aug. 20 last, I hope they will be able to exchange these for later reservations.
