We have received further information about the address of Mr. Tezlanka's parents. It is

I believe this is important as it seems there are many thousands in this Concentration Camp, and it may be very difficult to find the addresses.

Could this added information be sent by wire from the Embassy? Would you kindly let me know any expense that may be incurred, and I will gladly meet it.

Baeyens has gone off on a fortnight's leave. Otherwise, I would have communicated with him directly.
