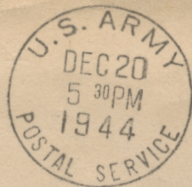

My Darling

Did you know that I Love you?
well I sure do and more than anything else
in all the world. My Sweet I miss
you so terribly much.

Tonight I am sitting in the Barocke
with not much to do except try to stay
warm and write to you. We had about
eight or ten inches of snow last night
but it is much different from the
snow that we usually get in Oklahoma.
It isn't accompanied by the winds here.
Just falls slowly to the ground in
big flakes. I wish you were here
so I could put snow down your back. ha

Honey I have missed only one day since
December 7, in writing to you and that was
Sunday when I went to town and didn't
get back until it was very late. I am
hoping that you are receiving them
regular. Darling I know that you are
writing to me each day, but for the
three letters I got yesterday, I haven't
heard from you in over a week. But
I'm not disappointed because there are
reasons for everything the army does.
Darling I am so proud that I can't say you
are my wife, I have more now than I
ever thought was possible for a bellair
like me to own in a life time. You
are the most wonderful girl in all the
world, and the only one that I have ever
really wanted for my wife. I'm not kidding
either, because I have plenty of time to think.

there may be times in the future, Darling, when
you won't hear from me for a long time.
If this should happen, don't be afraid because
I will always be with you, even though
we are miles apart. You can think of me
and know that I am thinking of you because
Darling I will be thinking of you always,
you will never be away from me. Honey
Someday soon, we will be together always.
Let us both pray every night and put our
faith in God and he will watch over us.

Burna and I went to the movies
tonight and saw a double feature. It
was a stinker but it saved me from
going nuts, thinking of you.

Honey say Hello to the folks for me
and for them to be good and write when
they can. I Love them like they were
my own parents. I had a letter from Harry
yesterday. He is fine and said Hello
to you. Maybe it won't be too long until
he can come home.

Be Good Darling and don't get discouraged
if you don't hear from me for awhile. I
will write you as often as I can. Write
mother often because I am going
to do most of my writing to you.
