Jess danced and choreographed professionally for METHOD, KAIROS, TONGUE, MULTIPLEX, and EARTH WIND & FIRE, to name a few. She received Lester Horton Awards for Outstanding Performance in a Company (TONGUE & METHOD) and has been nominated for Best Female Artist while dancing with METHOD. Her best creations are her two daughters. She feels blessed to live creatively, always with a sense of humor.
