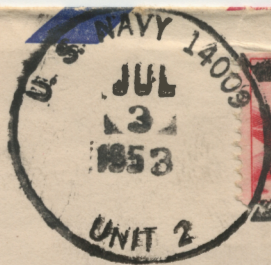

Just got your letter of June 22 here this afternoon and I was more than glad to know that everything are just fine you NAVAHOS. I think that you got last letter which I had mailed here not long ago.

I had been pretty busy here last three weeks now or until Monday morning and had a day off Tuesday. Aie rine and went to sleep alday too. That howthething went here last few days

You see that we have been getting new air plane from the stateside, We had to rewiring these plane here as they come out here.

You know what I got a letter from Nattie for the first time in two year but I have not answer her as yet. May be sometime this evening.

The trouble with me is when I start writing a letter and half of the page I run out thing to say, and I shit can the letter, I think that why you don't hear from me offen.

How the girls comeing along I am sure that they are in the best of everything, Give then my best love and big kiss for me honey. I have not hear from Willis or Ben as yet,

Well honey you asked me when I was coming home, will honey I don't think that I will be going no place for another two or three years from this squadron. I think that I had told you that I will stay with this squadron go back to the States which is some time this fall. ~~So you just keep your pants on until then will you.~~

Wills. let us call this a letter forn now until I do hear from you all . May god bless you and take care of you.
