Somewhere Deep in Germany.

My Beloved Wife,

Darling I am looking at the most beautiful woman in all the world, the picture of the woman I Love, your picture Darling. I Love you very much honey, and I shall Love you forever ever, do you mind Honey?

Sweetheart your picture brings me so much comfort, It makes me want to take you in my arms and give you a lovin like you never had before in all your life.



Honey we heard today that there was a rumor in the states that the war was over. <sup>tho</sup> I hope you didn't hear it honey because I don't want you to get your hopes up before it is all over. Then darling we can say our prayers and thank God together. I know he is going to answer our prayers and let us be together again one of these days darling. Let's keep our faith in him Honey forever & ever.

Honey I got a letter from a preacher from Kansas City, yesterday.



I had completely forgotten him  
but when I read the letter I  
remembered meeting him. I think  
it was just before we were  
married Honey, ah, that was  
the happiest day of my life up  
to now, the day I married you.

Honey I wouldn't take a  
million bucks for anyone of  
the days that we were together.  
Those, truly, were the happiest  
days of my life. Darling you  
are the only woman in the  
world, that I shall ever love.  
I Love you Darling, with all  
my heart and I'm not hidin'  
you one bit either.



Honey I guess the folks are going to be mad at me because I haven't written them in over a week.

I try to write them every week but I spend most of my spare time writing to you honey. they can just get mad if they want too.

Daddy I will try to write them soon, maybe tonight. I have a pretty good place to write tonight. I'm sitting in a good chair at a nice writing table, in a fine house which we liberated from the Kruats today.

Honey I know a real dirty joke, which I am almost afraid to tell you. Before I tell it honey, I want to



ask you to forgive me for being  
so rude. If you don't like the  
joke you can cut it off the letter  
as I am going to write it on  
the bottom of the page, <sup>the</sup> it is  
really crude.

Sweetheart I have been sending  
my letters to Texas for the  
last three or four days. you  
didn't say whether you intend  
to stay there long or not and  
you put Seminole for a return  
address but I am sending your  
letters to Gainesville anyway. <sup>the</sup>

Henry I wish you could  
get a good office job and live



with me, <sup>6.</sup> I'm sure you would  
feel better and time would  
go faster for you. Do as you like  
Honey but I'll tell you what I  
wish you would do. I wish you  
would go to Business College again  
and review your old subjects and  
learn short-hand, that would  
keep you busy for a good while  
and by the time I get home you  
should be an expert Book Keeper <sup>the</sup>  
wouldn't you like to do that Honey?  
Let me know what you think of  
the idea Honey. will ya?

Here's the joke Honey - you may not like it.  
"There was an old hermit named Dave, he  
kept a dead raven in his cave, he said,  
"I'll admit, I'm a bit of a shit, but look  
at the money I save."

Lee George, I wish I could take you  
in my arms right now and kiss  
you and love you Darling. I would  
love you till you were so weak that  
you couldn't stand alone. I really  
love you honey, with all my heart.

I have a prayer in my heart  
Darling, that we will be together  
again soon. I know God is watching  
over us sweetheart. Keep our faith  
in him and we will gain our  
reward some day.
