March 25 - April 1 Portsmouth Chamber Music Competition, preceded by a few days of vacationing in London, and followed by a week in Paris.

September 8 - 18 Paris, Yehudi Menuhin Competition

October 15 - November 15 Temianka Virtuosi Concert Tour of Western United States

Somewhere in between I am trying to sandwich the invitation from China to play the Beethoven Sonata Cycle in Bejiing and Shanghai, and to give master classes in both cities.
