In spite of not writing every day, it is amazing how often our thoughts are with you, wondering how you are and what you are doing. When I came home I played the Beethoven concerto and also appeared as soloist with our orchestra in a piece by Stenhammar at the Nobel Prize promotion in December 10th.
