I have always had trouble trying to make out what education in music should try to do. Connecting a composer's music with the dramatic events of his life does not somehow seem enough. It may awaken interest in the music, and it may fix facts about the composer's life or at least present an interpretation of his experience and behavior. But shouldn't education in music lead to some understanding of music as music? Shouldn't students learn what to listen for as in reading they should learn what to look for in a book?
