Born in Mission Viejo, **Heather Cano** began her musical studies on the clarinet at the age of seven. After switching to bassoon, she participated in the Kern County Honor Orchestra and the Orange County Youth Symphony Orchestra. Self-taught until her senior year of high school, she began private study with John Campbell in 1997. She is a graduating senior from Chapman University with double degrees in bassoon performance and music education. She is currently principal bassoon of the South Orange County Chamber Orchestra and has also performed with the University of California-Irvine Symphony Orchestra and has also performed with the Saddleback Church Orchestra and the Vietnamese American Youth Philharmonic. For the past two years, Heather has attended the Idyllwild Arts Summer Program where she played contrabassoon in the Festival Orchestra and Festival Wind Ensemble.

Anna Komandyan, a native of Armenia, is majoring in violin performance and music education. Following keyboard studies in early childhood, she undertook violin lessons at age 8. Her family emigrated to the United States in 1990. A year later, she enrolled in a private performing arts school in Los Angeles, where she continued her violin studies, sang in the choir, and took lessons in solfège and music theory. She also earned recognition in numerous solo competitions. While in junior high school, Anna was a member of the Los Angeles City College Orchestra. She attended Hamilton High School Academy of Music in Los Angeles. A student of Mischa Lefkowitz, she plans to graduate in May 2004.
