or

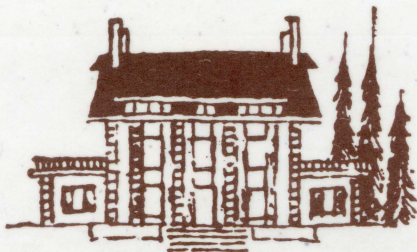
From STAMFORD: TURN RIGHT at TRAFFIC LIGHT and
