# Quilts of the Underground Railroad

## Secret Codes of Quilt

			It was used as a guide to find water, food and places to rest.	North uses the direction of traffic on the Underground Railroad.
Tumbling Blocks	Flying Geese	North Star	This signal was used to show the direction of Big Dipper constellation.	
			Follow a mountain trail out of view, and then follow an actual trail a trail which would lead to water and food.	
Bear's Paw	Wagon Wheel	Drunkard's Path	A warning signal to take a signal route to elude pursuing slave hunters and their hounds.	
			A symbol referring to a signal that involved broken crockery at some future landmark.	
Broken Dishes	Bow Tie	Monkey Wrench	to change from the clothing of a slave to those of a person of higher status.	
			A signal that either a body of water was nearby or that boats were available.	
Sailboat	Cross roads	Britches	A symbol indicating the escaping slave needed to dress as a free person.

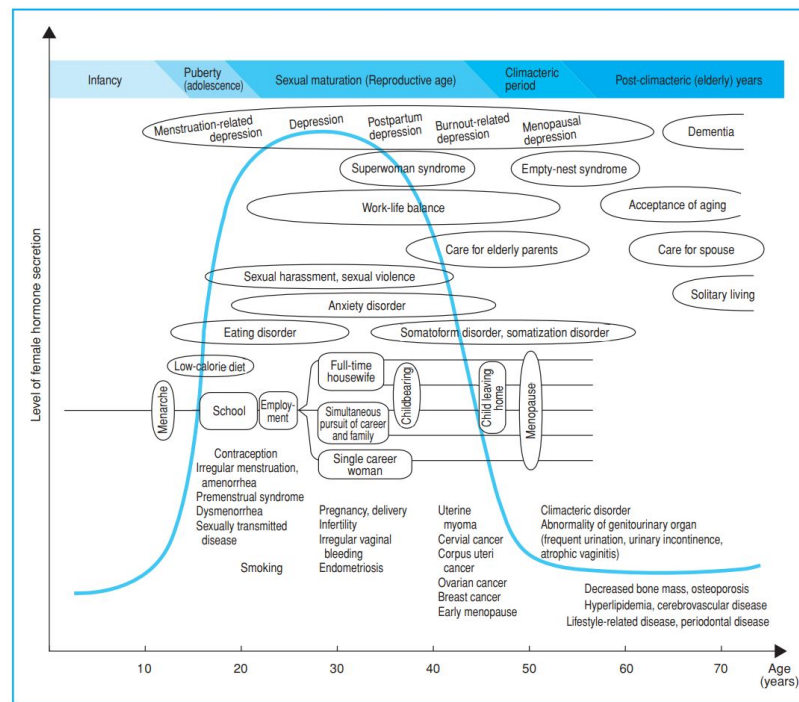


Fig. 1 Life stage related mental health issues and diseases unique to women
