Dear Jack:

You were admirably forthright in stating yesterday, with reference to the untreated root canal in tooth 31, "I was dead wrong" (your exact words). Mistakes do happen, but the fact is that because of that mistake, I developed an abscess which led to considerable expense and aggravation, including visits to my dentist, periodontist, and an oral surgeon, who treated me under sedation. Had these doctors been less caring and perceptive, the molar would have been unnecessarily extracted. Under these circumstances, my request that you delete an outstanding balance of some \$140.00 was excessively reasonable, and I am disappointed that you made an issue of it.

I am in a state of acute discomfort following yesterday's treatment, and want to go on record with these facts.
