DARLING FINK,

HERE IT IS MY BIRTHDAY NITE, AND I FEEL PRETTY GOOD TOO. I FEEL GOOD BECAUSE I FEEL SURE THAT THIS WILL BE THE LAST BIRTHDAY I'LL HAVE TO CELEBRATE IN THE ARMY. I'M JUST EATING THE LAST COOKIE IN THE CAN, AND THESE BIRTHDAY COOKIES SURE ARE DELICIOUS HONEY.

I GOT A TRIP THIS MORNING. JUST A TWENTY FIVE MILE HAUL, BUT IT SEEMED GOOD TO BE ON THE ROAD AGAIN.

IN THE PAPER TONITE THERE WAS MORE NEWS ABOUT THE SENATORS TELLING THE ARMY TO SPEED UP THE DEMOBILAZATION. THOSE BOYS KNOW WHERE THERE VOTES ARE COMING FROM, AND I BELIEVE THEY'RE GOING TO GET RESULTS

I HAVEN'T HAD A LETTER FROM YOU SINCE DAY BEFORE YESTERDAY SO MAYBE TOMORROW WILL BE THE DAY AGAIN. I LOVE TO GET YOUR LETTERS DARLING. YOU WRITE SUCH SWELL ONES. IT'S ALMOST LIKE HEARING YOU TALK TO ME. THOSE LAST TWO CAME SO FAST THAT I REALLY COULDN'T EXPECT TO GET ONE TODAY.

HOW ARE YOU GETTING ALONG ON YOUR JOB HONEY? IT'S NOT QUITE AS HARD WORK AS YOU HAD AT BENDIX, IS IT? ONE OF THESE FINE DAYS YOU WONT HAVE TO BE WORKING ANYPLACE SWEETIE. I'LL LET YOU WORK FOR ME. HOW WILL YOU LIKE THAT DARLING? THE PAY MIGHT NOT BE AS GOOD AS YOU ARE USED TO, BUT YOU CAN COLLECT IN LOVE AND KISSES. OH DARLING, IT'S GOING TO BE SO WONDERFUL BEING TOGETHER AGAIN. YOU'RE SUCH A WONDERFUL PRECIOUS DARLING TO COME HOME TO. YOU ALWAYS LOOK SO NEAT AND SWEET WHEN I COME HOME IN THE AFTERNOON. OF COURSE YOU LOOK SO NEAT AND SWEET ALL THE TIME, BUT I HAVEN'T SEEN YOU ALL DAY, AND THAT'S A LONG TIME TO BE AWAY FROM MY LITTLE LOVER. HONEY I'LL JUST WANT TO EAT YOU UP. I'M GOING TO BE SUCH A PROUD KID WHEN I CAN TAKE YOU PLACES AGAIN SWEETIE. OH DARLING, IT'S SO WONDERFUL TO BE MARRIED TO YOU.

YOU KNOW HONEY, I FEEL LIKE A CIVILIAN SITTING HERE IN THESE GOOD PAJAMAS. I SURE DO LIKE THEM. I SLEPT SO NICE AND WARM LAST NITE TOO.

ALL MY LOVE TO THE DEAREST AND SWEETEST AND BEST WIFE IN ALL THE WORLD.
