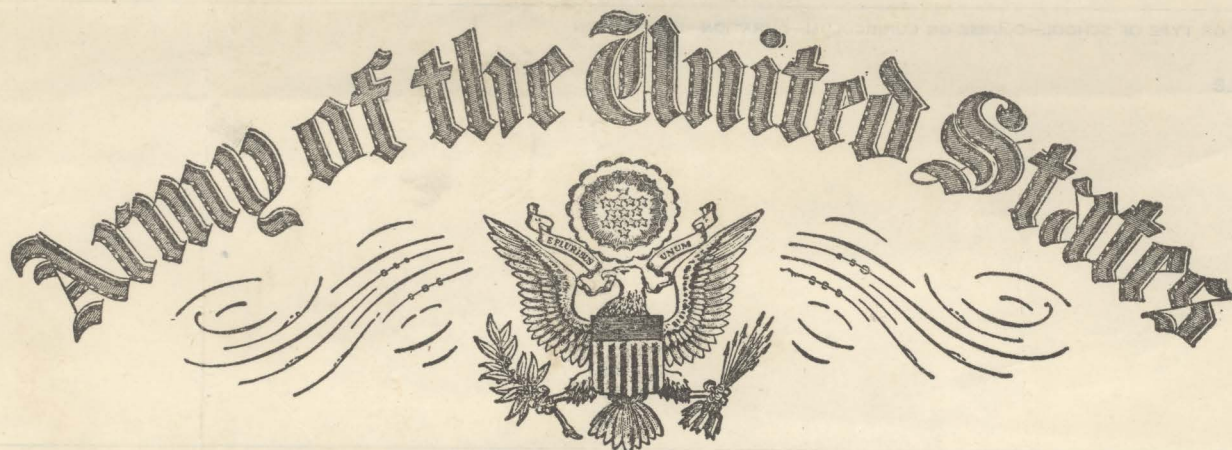

Installed, maintained, repaired, and operated refrigeration equipment used to preserve perishable foods in a mobile refrigeration unit. Installed and assembled condensers compressors, and motors. Used detector to detect leaks. Installed piping packing, valves, and pipe couplings. Used such tools as wrenches, pliers, and pipe cutting and threading tools. Served in the European Theater for 17 months.
