It looks O.K. for our projected concert on Nov .24th. I am assuming that you help prepare the orchestra before I arrive to take over the last two rehearsals on the 23rd and morning of the 24th.

Could you send me a contract that spells and out the terms of our agreement fairly soon. I am off tomorrow for concerts with the Cincinnati Orchestra but will be back home by the 21st.

One other consideration: I should very much like it if you could engage a singer soloist; either a soprano who could do my Eight Poems of Emily Dickinson with the chamber orchestra, lasting 20 minutes, or the Old American Songs for baritone; or preferably both.
