Thank you for your kind remarks commending my action on behalf of the County Music and Performing Arts Commission and retention of its budget.

As I indicated during the extraordinary budget sessions, I remain firmly convinced that government, in a limited manner, must share in the support of the cultural arts which are so vital to the development and preservation of a fully complexed society.
