Dear Henri Temianka,

I have made inquiries, and I have been told by competent persons that it would only be a waste of time to make the necessary steps through the German Consulate. The only way would be to take a specialist lawyer like Dr. Heinz A. Pinner (8105 West 3rd Street, Los Angeles 36) or Dr. Harry D. Salinger (9201 Wilshire Bd. Beverly Hills). Since they get a percentage they have every interest in the outcome. But I would advise you to ask them how high the fee would be for a first consultation.

Both will know your name - I am sure. And I am also sure they will be interested. If you want me to call them and inquire about the fee, it would be my pleasure to do so.

All the same I would also get in touch with the German Consulate General, and I enclose a draft for a letter to the Consul General Dr. Kiderlen.
