Dear Mr. Pickler:

Thank you for your letter of June 1, which was delivered here only on June 15. To set the record straight, the first letter you sent me in April had no date on it, and reached me at the end of that month. I promptly replied by letter, cable and two attempted telephone calls. From that time to this I never heard from you again. In the meantime I wrote to you again on May 22, which letter you have now acknowledged. All this time I have kept the requested period open, beginning with August 27. I shall be conducting in Sweden until August 25, and am free to fly to Israel the following day. I shall be happy to conduct the string orchestra and record a solo concerto. Obviously, if we are limited to string accompaniment, we must think in terms of a Bach or Vivaldi concerto. If I am also to conduct and record a work for string orchestra alone, we have a very wide choice, ranging from:
