Dear Mr. Temianka:


As you may know by now, the Federal District Court judge in Boston, Massachusetts has made a ruling that Air Canada was not negligent nor responsible for the fall taken by Jim on December 15, 1979. This took place at a liability only hearing, on September 5 and 6, 1984. Most certainly it was an unfortunate decision.

If I may, I also write with regard to a misunderstanding related to your potential travel arrangements to Boston on September 6 and 7.
