I am distressed to read your letter of September 11, 1984 and to learn of the judge's disastrous decision in the case of James Fields v. Air Canada. From your description of the events, I gather that my journey to Boston would have been entirely futile, since the case was thrown out of court prior to the date on which my appearance was scheduled. I do appreciate your concern and thoughtfulness in apprising me of the unfortunate course of events.

I should have mentioned to you when we last spoke to each other, that my erroneous assumption that I was no longer expected on September 7 was based in part on the fact that some months earlier, a previous hearing date had been canceled without my being informed. Please believe that my friendship and devotion for Jimmy remain undiminished, and should you decide to appeal the judge's decision, you may absolutely count on my support and presence.
