Our letters crossed so I am answering both yours of the 7th and 9th in one fell swoop. Incidentally, please forgive the type-writing but you can imagine what life is like, not only here in London but also preparing for the 'hegira' to Gstaad, and I do not want to keep you waiting.

We shall be delighted to see that your son Daniel, his wife Gail and the children Ariel and Etham will be in Gstaad on the 19th August at the Belle Vue and are only sorry that their stay is so short, and that also there happens to be no concert on that night. On Tuesday, 18th, there is a concert of the New European Strings conducted by Dimitry Sitkovetsky, and on the 20th Yehudi is conducting the marvellous Sinfonia Varsovia with Paul Meyer in a lovely programme - the first Prokofiev, then the Mozart Clarinette Concert and the No.4 Beethoven Symphony. If they could possibly change their date to the 20th, we would be delighted to see that they have 4 tickets. Otherwise, rehearsals permitting, we will try to see that at least they come up to the chalet. Do let me know as soon as possible because the concerts are likely to be rather heavily booked.
