We are immediately going ahead and are putting the HANDEL Sonatas into works, and there is a good opportunity that we will be able to issue it by September.



It would, of course, be a wonderful thing if we could issue it on one CD (74 minutes), but I am afraid this will not be feasible and therefore we might want to do Op. 59 plus Op. 74 on two CDs.
