Dear Mr. Temianka:

It was a pleasure for me to talk to you after such a long time.

We are willing to issue the 15 HAENDEL Sonatas on two CDs. Our idea is, if the cost permits it, to offer the two CDs of the complete Haendel Sonatas for the price of one full-price CD. I am afraid this is the only way we can sell it.

What I need from you is not only a SONY 1610 tape, but also the texts, commonly known as liner notes, which you want us to include. It should not go over 3 printed pages (format is the CD booklet which you know), because there is a good likelihood that Germany would want to make a translation of the text and issue a booklet both in English and German, and we might also have illustrations in the text. Please include also whatever you wish to say about yourself and possibly even a photo.

We suggest that we pay you a royalty of 75¢ for the package for all sales made in the United States, 50¢ a package for all sales made overseas.

May I remind you that you also wanted to send me the list of recordings of the Paganini Quartet, etc.
