I didn't want to answer your letters until the Triple Concerto was actually finished. Now it is, and the premiere by Stokowsky will take place on October 6. I am still much too near the piece to be able to tell you how I feel about it and I am not even sure yet about its length. A rough guess would be 15 minutes. For the material you should write to Hans Hanzheimer, c/o G. Schirmer.

Please let me know as soon as possible the date of your performance, as Spring 1971 is a very busy period for me.

It is very possible that I shall be in Los Angeles for a week or ten days at the beginning of December, to oversee the City Center production of AMAHL and THE GLOBOLINKS there, so we shall probably see each other then.
