
Dear Henri,

It is very difficult indeed not to be forced into extreme positions. I did not join the total boycott and I certainly do not join the total condemnation of Israel by the voices which ganged up at the last General Conference of Unesco.

I still hope that at the next Executive Meeting of the Unesco Council these resolutions will be rescinded. I believe I read in your letter something of the same approach.

As you say, you would wish me to appeal for moderation not just from one group but from Jew, Christian and Moslem alike, this is indeed what I am trying to do.
