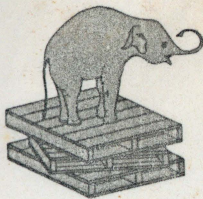

Dear Mr. Temianka,

Thank you for your letter of October 15, 1981, and the kind words you have written about me anent the most important legal victory against the IHR, et al.

I took the liberty in sharing your kind letter with a number of my colleagues, survivors of the Holocaust and with my attorney, in which you are offering assistance in the matter. Therefore, I wonder if it would be appropriate for me to ask you to arrange, in the near future, a benefit concert on behalf of the Mermelstein Trust Account to defray legal expenses and to further cover future legal discovery and other expenses in the matter.

As you may know, since your letter dated Oct. 15th, the judge reiterated his "judicial notice" of Oct. 9th. However, he further stated that facts exist that must be tried, including the "nature of any contract or agreement." This will no doubt entail a great deal of legal effort. Without sufficient funds, it will be difficult to present a strong case against the (as your letter states) "forces of darkness that threaten all of us."

Your earliest response will greatly be appreciated.
