
Dear Mr. Temianka:

Thank you so much for your recent letter. It sounds exciting--  
your trip to Mexico City.

In answer to your questions: Yes, the apartment will have two bedrooms. The apartment will be on one side of Kent and the dining room will be on the opposite side of a very large campus, and therefore most of our faculty who do live in apartments prefer to prepare their own meals.
