Woman Violinist Is Signed By Philadelphia Orchestra



LOIS ZU PUTLITZ

THE Philadelphia Orchestra has under contract the first woman violinist in its history, it was learned last night.

She is Lois zu Putlitz, wife of Sylvan Levin, pianist, conductor, and teacher at the Curtis Institute of Music. They live in Berwyn.

After studying at Curtis, Miss zu Putlitz won a reputation in concert work. She was married to Levin in Elkton, Md., in 1931.

While it was known the contract was signed, the orchestra management gave out no details.
