Dear Henri,

John and I both want to thank you for your letter and for your charming suggestion of making your splendid annual event a tribute to John and myself. In principal this would be lovely. It just depends how soon you need to know definitely about a date. I have asked the Houston Symphony for the details of our February/March tour with the orchestra but at the moment these are not complete. Certain dates are fixed; it seems that we shall play in Los Angeles on 1st March, and near Los Angeles on 2nd March, and it is likely, although not of course certain, that the 3rd 4th or 5th could be a free day in that region, but when this will be finally fixed I really do not know. When it is fixed it must also depend on exactly where and how heavy the schedule is surrounding the free day.

We shall both understand entirely if you would rather fix your affairs now. If, on the other hand, you would feel like waiting a little, I will of course let you know as soon as the tour arrangements are finalised.
