Dear Henri:

Thanks very much for your letter of June 4, which I would have acknowledged before, except that I have been abroad in the interval.

I am now definitely going to plan to leave here late in the day of October 2, so that I will surely be on time for the luncheon on October 3. The date for my lecture at UCLA, ~~which was~~ October 7, is all right for me, but I must leave on Thursday the 8th. I look forward to my visit, and want you to know that if the choral-chamber music concert is too difficult to arrange, why not just skip it? It did occur to me, however, that you might want the chorus to perform at the luncheon. For example, they could do twenty minutes to a half-hour or so, and this might liven the affair. In addition to this thought, I now see that the change of date from early in the new year to October causes a problem on the String Trio. The Library of Congress naturally expects the world premiere, and their program does not take place until the end of the month. It is conceivable that Mr. Spivacke could permit the West Coast premiere, but highly unlikely, and I would not like to ask him. In any case, do let me have your thoughts.
