
Dear Henri,

Thank you for your thoughtfulness in writing your note just before leaving New York after the Irving Berlin Gala Bash. I am sorry I could not get back to you but I have rarely been so frantic as in those few days. There were several functions over which I had to preside, all the preparations for this rather enormously complicated television show as well as, not the least important or taxing, preparation and rehearsals with the New York Philharmonic for the New York premiere of the Peter Maxwell Davies concerto and a performance of a Mozart concerto. There were very few hours even to sleep!

As it was always intended to be a "pop" show, I thought it turned out well. We shall see the total results when it is telecast on May 27 Coast to Coast on CBS.
