Upon receipt of the 1990 Boosey & Hawkes Music Diary, we note that the name of Henri Temianka, in previous years always listed under the date of November 19, is absent this time. We hope that this is just an oversight. His biography continues to appear in Groves, Who's Who, Baker's, and other reference works. His recordings were reviewed in The Strad Magazine just a few months ago. He was honored for distinguished services by the American String Teachers Association earlier this year.
