If you go back, please, and re-read it, you will find that I was speaking of the polarities and paradoxes of a difficult world, which if we do not understand will surely destroy us, one and all. If the Catholissmisunderstand the Protestants in Northern kikindk Ireland, and the Protestants polarize themselves against the Catholics, they will self-destroy. HAVE DOZONS If the Russians continue to misunderstand we capitalists and we capitalist Americans continue thep to polarize against the Russians, we will eventually destroy ourselves. If the white people do not understand blacks and blacks refuse to understand whites, we will annihilate ourselves in a race war. If the old misunderstand the young and the young go on thinking that all older people are fools we will seff-destroy out of the paradoxes and polarities. If Christian and Moslem and Jew go on polarizing themselves in the Mid-East, continuing to hate instead of trying to comprehend, adjust, sit down, make do, and finally, try, try, try to love, Israel will no longer exist in the year 2001 and we will be plunged into such a war of destruction as will shake and inundate the world, taking all, all, all of us I do not want such destruction, you do not want it, no body wants it. Yet the polarization continues.

Re-read my message of love again. I would hope to hear from you this evening by telephone telling me that you now understand what I was trying to say, and you apologize for your letter of miscomprehension to me, which was written out of haste, I am sure.
