

That editing is waiting for Temianka to come to my studio and supervise the editing, which he has a right to do. From such an editorial session there will emerge a complete tape of a complete performance representing the best takes of each section. At that point, my engineer will be most happy to knock off a disc set for you. I cannot turn the unedited tapes over to your son. Temianka tells me that he will very presently have the editorial session of which I speak, and it will then be my pleasure to present you with a copy to put on your phonograph and play. I am not being either artistically or business-wise "chintzy"; there just is, at the moment, no continuous and contiguous performance of which to make a copy; there is a mass of un-edited takes; it's that simple.
