It is a long time since we have been in touch with each other. I hope you are in good health. I have had a very busy season as conductor and soloist, and my book, "Facing the Music", has just been published by David McKay in New York. The subtitle is "An Irreverent Close-Up of the Real Concert World".

I have received an invitation from the Haslemere Festival to appear there as viclin soloist this summer of 1973. Much as I would like to accept this invitation, it would not be practical for me to make the long trip from California to England unless additional engagements could be tied in with The Haslemere Festival. I now have a letter from Ms. Greta Mathews, Festival Secretary, suggesting that I write to you to inquire whether it would be possible to combine other engagements with my Festival appearance.
