Jan Jordan, is a respected pianist in both jazz and classical styles of music. A professional musician since the age of thirteen, Jan comes from a prestigious musical family. His grandfather, Jan Kubelik, was a world-famous Czech violinist, and his uncle, Rafael Kubelik, was a world-famous symphony conductor. His jazz trio has had steady engagements at some of the finest venues in Orange County, including the Ritz Carlton, the Four Seasons, Bowers Museum and Diva. Mr. Jordan is also a dedicated music educator whose students have won many awards and honors.

Robert (Bob) Messenger is a multi-talented bassist and woodwind player of saxophones, flutes and clarinets. He is best known for his work with the Carpenters. Bob performed, recorded and tours for the Carpenters on both bass and woodwinds. The beautiful melodic saxophone solos on the Carpenters' hit recordings were Bob's creations. Today, Bob is busy freelancing all over Southern California on both bass and woodwinds.
